



Hong Kong Innovation Foundation Provides Educational Support for Children amid Class Suspension

The Hong Kong Innovation Foundation (HKIF) provided educational support for children from underprivileged families amid class suspension.

Schools have adopted online learning so that students can continue schooling amid class suspension. The HKIF has donated 1,000 mobile data SIM cards, each with a capacity of 50GB and validity of 365 days, through 12 NGOs and primary schools to students from underprivileged families to facilitate online learning during this period. The data SIM cards have been made available at a special rate from China Mobile Hong Kong thanks to their gracious support. Additionally, over 100 laptops / tablets have been lent to students who encounter difficulties in procuring a computer for online learning.

'Children's learning continuity is of utmost importance to their growth and development at this critical stage. We are glad that like-minded partners have worked together to explore ways to support children's continued learning amid the current situation,' remarks Mr Daryl Ng, Chairman of the HKIF.
